With temperatures rising, the welfare of both our horses and riders remains our top priority.

At Barnfields Riding Stables, we continuously monitor weather conditions and may make adjustments to lessons and activities where necessary. This could include shorter riding sessions, increased rest and water breaks, additional shade breaks, or alternative horse care and learning activities.

Please remember to:

-  Bring plenty of water.
-  Wear appropriate sun protection.
-  Dress in light, comfortable clothing suitable for riding.
-  Apply sunscreen before your lesson.

Our horses will also be closely monitored, with workloads adjusted as required to ensure they remain comfortable and happy in the heat.

As always, horse welfare comes first. If conditions become too hot for safe riding, we may replace part or all of a lesson with unmounted activities, stable management, horse care, or educational sessions. These are all valuable parts of becoming a knowledgeable and well-rounded horse person.
